Hundreds of RentPath corporate and field employees showed up to projects on and off site. There were 15 Ambassadors to recruit, lead, and inspire their peers nationwide.



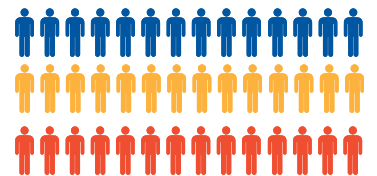
